MINOR PUPPY DOG (2)

1st Siddle, Siddle & Mazzeo's – Wilchrimane Cereal Killer. Won on movement as 2nd placed was having a naughty day and did not co-operate with handler when it came to moving. Not overwhelmed with is head although it was acceptable. Presented a balanced outline with good height to length proportions so well made throughout.

2nd Booth & Oddie's – Lundgarth Fly The Flag. What a loving head with a kind expression. Good wide nostrils. Straight front with tight fitting elbows. Well laid shoulders with strong topline. Good width of thigh. Movement could not be assessed due to his playful antics.

PUPPY DOG (3,1) Repeat of Minor Puppy.

JUNIOR DOG (7,2)

1st Pearson's – Ladyhawke Desert Orchid. Attractive masculine head with intelligent expression. Mature for his age. Nice reach of neck flowing into the withers. Good forechest and layback of shoulder. Strong over the loin. Wide thighs with moderate bend of stifle. Correct tail set and carriage. Sound if both directions. Must have a bright future.

2nd Swannell's – Sharnphilly Black Abbott. Not nearly as mature as 1. Pleasing head with correct ear set and soft expression. Clean overall outline. Good straight front with strong pasterns and tight feet. Strong topline with well developed hindquarters Moved with style.

3rd Saunders & Newton's – Teisgol Calendula.

GRADUATE DOG (10,1)

1st Wilcox's – Harvestslade Fire And Ice through Merynjen. He is all dog but carrying a bit too much weight over the shoulder which slightly spoils his overall outline. Apart from that he is teeming with quality. Attractive masculine head with well shaped and coloured eye. Good straight front with tight fitting elbows. Strong bone with tight feet. Deep in brisket. Well muscled hindquarters. Tail carried slightly high on the move. Covered the ground with ease.

2nd O'Neill's –Tenshilling Shboom. Nice example of the breed and possesses many qualities. Pleasing head with alert expression. Excellent layback of shoulder and return of upper arm. Good straight front with tight feet. Strong topline. Well developed hindquarters. Once he got into his stride and settled, he moved positively.

3rd Martin's - Sunhouse I'll Be Back.

POST GRADUATE DOG (6)

1st Philo's – Sunhouse Black Is Back at Salmonmist JW (Ai). He was my star of the day. First thing I noticed about him was his wonderful temperament as his tail never stopped wagging. What about those laughing dark eyes. I am sure he was smiling at me. A dog full of quality with no exaggerations and who was moved at the correct pace. Tight fitting elbows with well laid back shoulders. Good straight front with strong pasterns. Strong over the loin. Well muscled hindquarters. Good head and tail carriage on the move. Well handled. A pleasure to award him his first CC.

2nd Rose's – De Las Navazuelas Stormcloud at Ridanflight (Imp ESP). Presents a balanced outline. Very attractive well proportioned head with dark eye. Well laid shoulders. Strong bone with tight feet. Longer cast than 1 with strong topline held on the move. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. Covered the ground with ease and style. RCC.

3rd Norbury & Ganney's Heartbury Matador JW.

LIMIT DOG (4)

1st Tibbs' – Raigmore Keep The Faith. Pleasing head with good dark eye. Typical expression. Good straight front with tight fitting elbows. Strong bone with tight feet. Strong, reachy neck. Deep in brisket. Well ribbed body and strong over the loin. Well muscled hindquarters. Nice happy temperament with tail wagging the whole time. Would like to see him a bit more settled on the move.

2nd Preece & Gilding's – Harvestslade Light Of Peace. Dog of many qualities and no exaggerations. Balance personified. Liked his height to length dimensions. Attractive masculine head with kind expression. Short in couplings. Excellent forward reach and drive from behind.

3rd Ram's – Jilony Brown Velvet.

OPEN DOG (6,2)

1st Oddie's – Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW. Such an eye catching dog. Quality from nose to tail. Such an attractive masculine head with. Eye rims and nose dark with hazel eyes. I love the way his strong neck flows into the withers and continues into strong topline. Well laid shoulders and good straight front. Strong over loin. In such hard condition. For me his hindquarters are slightly over angulated. His strong hocks assist with him powering around the ring with good forward reach. A worthy title holder.

2nd Philo's – Sh Ch Tenshilling It's My Party for Salmonmist JW OSW ShCEx. Another great dog of many qualities and no exaggerations Shorter coupled than 1. Such a well muscled body throughout. Attractive head with good proportions. Strong, reach neck. Adequate lay back of shoulder. Good straight front with tight fitting elbows. Deep in brisket with well sprung ribs. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. A little proud of his tail on the move. Another one with good happy temperament. A worthy title holder. 3rd Adams' – Carofel Wings Of Hope JW Ww23 Swiss Jch

VETERAN DOG (2)

1st Jamieson, Macara & Blackburn-Bennett's – Sh Ch Kanix Peri Peri with Glenfinnan. A favourite of mine over the past recent years. 7 year old who excels on the move which is a pleasure to watch. Pleasing head with intelligent expression and hazel eye. Wide nostrils. Such a well muscled, short coupled body. Tight feet with strong pasterns. A bit overstretched for me when standing. Good head and tail carriage. Another worthy Title holder.

2nd O'Neill's - Sh Ch Tenshilling Home Alone JW ShCM. Ten year old losing out to a much younger boy. Did not have the drive as 1 had. Well made throughout with no exaggerations. I loved his head and expression but is lacking pigmentation. Good front assembly. Short in couplings with strong loin. Well developed moderate hindquarters. Good breed type.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (4)

1st Booth's – Lundgarth Ticket To Fly. Excelled on the move for one so young. The sweetest of feminine heads with kind expression. Correct ear set. Well laid back shoulders. Strong topline. Good width of thigh and bend of stifle. Strong hocks with good head and tail carriage.

2nd Kennedy's – Droveborough Black Magic. Loved her overall balance but she wasn't keen on moving on the day. Quite mature for her age. Feminine head with so much work in it. Excellent clean lines throughout. Very promising once she settles down ad decides to move.

3rd Barham's – Droveborough Witchy Woman.

PUPPY BITCH (5)

1st Matthews' – Sonham Just A Pretty Belle. Presents a very balanced outline with no exaggerations. Pleasing head but prefer darker eye. Correct ear set. Well laid back shoulders with return of upper arm. Good straight front with tight fitting elbows. Strong neck flowing into withers. Level backline with good tail set and carriage. Well developed hindquarters with wide thighs and bend of stifle. Strong hocks and tight feet. Simply flowed around the ring with little effort and what about that forward reach. One to look out for in the future. BP.

2nd Tibbs' – Raigmore Titania. Has to settle on the move. It's all there apart from settled movement. Sweet, feminine head with kind expression. Well constructed throughout. Level topline continuing onto well set tail. Wide thighs.

3rd Booth's - Lundgarth Ticket To Fly.

JUNIOR BITCH (4)

1st Stilgoe & Fox's – Teisgol Rose Campion. A lot to like about this one and she must have a bright future. Classical head. Hazel eye with intelligent, kind expression. Short in couplings and strong over the loin. Adequate lay of shoulder with good straight front. Strong pasterns with tight feet. Hindquarters still have time to fully develop. Excelled on the move which was effortless.

2nd Kennedy's – Droveborough's Hells Bells. Another one who caught my eye for her many qualities. Presents a totally balanced outline with her height to length dimensions. Pleasing mature head with good hazel eye and typical expression. Adequate layback of shoulder with good straight front. Strong neck flowing into withers. Deep in brisket for one so young. Strong, level topline. Correct tail set and carriage. Stylish movement in both directions.

3rd Millett's Laveto Tennessee Whiskey.

GRADUATE BITCH (13,3)

1 and 2 was a repeat of 1 and 2 in Junior.

3rd Preece & Gilding's - Harvestslade Star Ruby.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (2)

1st Roberts' – Kananaskis Black Bryony. Pleasing outline with sweet, feminine head and kind expression. Correct ear set. Good straight front and no exaggerations in any department. Moved truly and positively in both directions and good head and tail carriage.

2nd Cardiff's – Freebreeze Pixar at Prosperity. Pleasing head with kind expression. Strong neck with good front assembly. Good bone with strong pasterns and tight feet. Falls away at croup. Moved soundly.

LIMIT BITCH (16,5)

1st Norbury & Adams' – Heartbury Northern Lights JW. Beautiful bitch who shows herself off to her best. She is totally balanced in every department but has to watch her weight. Classical head with so much work in it. Good lay of shoulder and forechest. Deep in brisket. Strong topline and loin. A bit long cast but I don't mind that in a bitch. Wide thighs and strong hocks. Free and effortless movement with her feet hardly touching the ground. Top honours should come. RCC

2nd Blackburn-Bennett's – Kanix Skyfall. Eye catching shape but would like to see more flesh covering the ribs. Pleasing head with intelligent expression. Strong reach neck. Adequate lay of shoulder. Good straight front with tight fitting elbows. Strong bone with tight feet. Level topline. Correct tail set and carriage. Excelled on the move which gained her placing.

3rd Tibbs' – Raigmore Faith In The Future.

OPEN BITCH (7,2)

1st Rossiter & Fewster's – Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Joneva Just A Kiss JW ShCEx OSW Cw'25. Liked her height to length dimensions. Nothing overdone about her. Loved her head and expression. Everything in proportion. Correct ear set. Nice flow of neck into withers. Deep in brisket and good width of thigh. Nice bend of stifle and strong over the loin. Covered the ground with ease and style and was a pleasure to watch her good forward reach and drive from behind BCC & BOB

2nd Macara & Blackburn-Bennett's - Sh Ch Kanix Sooty at Stargang. Good overall quality with clean, unbroken lines. Pleasing, feminine head with dark eye. Excellent straight front with good lay back of shoulder. Strong topline. For me she is a bit over angulated at the rear. Strong hocks. Excelled on the move albeit moved way too fast.

3rd Webb's – Tenshilling The Wanderer.

VETERAN BITCH (5)

1st Oliver's – Olivesong Kiss Chase. Possesses good breed type. Attractive feminine head. Prefer to see longer neck. Good bone with strong pasterns. Strong topline held on the move. Correct tail set. Well muscled hindquarters. Moved soundly in both directions.

2nd Young's – Gundioy Reflection Within. Quite a big girl with short couplings. Pleasing head with sweet expression. Good dark eye. Good straight front with tight fitting elbows. Attentive to handler. Mature, true movement.
