1st Scotland's Daledancer Victor McDade, 8-month o/w, super head shape and dish for his age, made along clean lines, well arched neck leading to well-placed shoulders. Super bone and feet, deep through the chest, super body and quarters moved well.

2nd O'Neill's Tenshilling Hello Stranger, 7 month b/w enjoying his day out, pleasing head and shoulders, correct body proportions for his age, when settled moved well.

3rd Jamieson's Kanix Tiswas at Glenfinnan.

PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Smith & Welch's Quinnery Swinderby by Lypal, 11 month o/w up for size, clean head and correct dish, correct ear set, moderate neck leading to well placed shoulders and super front assembly, standing on good tight feet, with ample bone. Super body and quarters, correct topline and moved very well, one to watch for the future.

2nd Booth & Oddie's Lundgarth Fly The Flag, 10 month slightly smaller frame than the winner none the less couldn't be overlooked here today, pleasing head shape with correct eye shape and colour. Deep in chest for his age and well bodied moved and shown to advantage.

2nd Henshaw & Goodchild's Berseydale Straight Flush with Peteshe (Imp MLT), b/w a little erratic in front movement which cost him the class, pleasing head and expression, deep through the chest correct rear angles and strong quarters

3rd Wall & Dunn's Meadowpoint Spooktacular.

GRADUATE DOG (11,2)

1st Sardu's Radussini Biondo Tevere, o/w stallion male pleasing head and expression, clean neck and well placed shoulders, deep chest and well bodied ample bone strong quarters won on his front movement and balance.

2nd Heaton's Freebreeze On Location at Brackenstyle, b/w another stallion male super head and dish, deep through the chest, correct length of loin and rear angles moved ok.

3rd Millett's Riowood Orange Twist.

POST GRADUATE DOG (11,2)

1st Trueman's Bradleypoint Floki, fell for this male, well headed masculine expression, but not overdone in any way. Correct fore chest and lay of shoulder, leading to straight front and correct feet. Deep chest and loin length, super quarters and topline, moved with ease and drive.

2nd Martin's Sunhouse I'll Be Black (ai) b/w with super head and expression, clean neck leading to well placed shoulders, bone and feet, deep chest, little longer in loin than winner, correct rear quarters moved true both ways.

3rd Webster's Joneva Just Goes To Show at Errytar.

1st Rose's De Las Navazuelas Stormcloud at Ridanflight (Imp ESP) b/w with pleasing head and eye, masculine but without coarseness, correct dish and eye. Clean neck leading to super lay of shoulder, enough bone, correct forechest and depth, well bodied with length of loin, well muscled rear quarters which he used effortlessly to motor around the ring, keeping his topline.

2nd Philo's Sunhouse Black Is Back at Salmonmist JW (ai), another pleasing b/w beautiful head and expression clean neck and shoulders, well bodied strong quarters and moved very well.

3rd Webb's Tenshilling Jimmy Mack JW

OPEN DOG (8)

1st CC, BOB, Gp1, Res BIS, Oddie's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW, this b/w could not be denied his awards today, this is the best I have seen him, he was at the top of his game and collected his awards accordingly. I have judged this male before and today I felt he had matured into a masculine pointer without coarseness. correct head shape with required dish which enhanced his masculine expression, clean through the neck with correct lay of shoulder, good forechest, bone and feet, deep brisket, well bodied and correct length of loin, kept his topline on the move and standing, he went around the ring with confidence and power, shown and presented well.

2nd Adams' Sh Ch Carofel Wings Of Hope JW Ww23 Swiss Jr Ch, o/w with pleasing head, masculine but not overdone, correct front assembly, clean neck and shoulders, deep chest, well bodied with correct topline, super quarters movement well.

2nd Lowe's Lowsmoor Half A Sixpence JW, o/w pretty expressional 7-year-old, all the attributes required, neck, shoulders, good bone, bodied and moved very well.

3rd Welch, Maber & Hazeltine's Sharnphilly Toggi with Hookwood JW

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (6,1)

1st BP, Hinton, Luke & Leman's Fleurfield Betty Barclay, b/w promising puppy, beautiful feminine head and expression with correct length of muzzle, clean neck and shoulders, well boned and correct front angulation, clean through the body with positive rear movement, well let down hocks.

2nd Crocker & Frost's De Las Navazuelas Judeline at Riverbrue (Imp ESP), o/w 6-month-old, feminine head with good pigment, clean neck and well placed shoulders. Today I felt she was carrying a little too much weight which spoilt her balance and didn't help her movement.

3rd Upton-Lovett & Upton's Heartbury Endless Love with Roydack

PUPPY BITCH (4,1)

1st Kennedy's Droveborough Black Magic, b/w lovely balanced female, super head and expression with correct dish. She had good bone and forechest, deep through the chest for her age, well bodied with moderate rear angles, moved very well.

2nd Booth's Lundgarth Ticket To Fly, another in this class with a pleasing feminine expression, clean neck and shoulders, enough bone, well bodied and moved well, fell away over the croup a little for me which spoilt her balance in the final placings.

3rd Barham's Droveborough Witchy Woman

1st Wilkinson's Ferndel Sapphire Mist over Stocksfell, a lovely type of b/w, feminine expression, with correct ear shape and eye. She had a very good lay of shoulder with good bone and feet, well bodied, super quarters and topline, moved with drive and purpose.

2nd Gates' Sharnphilly Dizzy Blonde at Linosa, o/w, super feminine expression, deep through the chest, well bodied and super quarters, correct topline moved well covering the ground with purpose.
