#### **MINOR PUPPY DOG** (4 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> STILGOE, Mr And Mrs P And D & FOX, Mrs Lisa Teisgol Sweet William, 8 months, promising with a refined and well balanced head, pleasing symmetry of outline, moved on a steady stride, correct use and carriage of tail.

2<sup>nd</sup> PEARSON, Mrs Ladyhawke Desert Orchid, 8 months, a size larger than winner, not as pleasing in outline, nor quite as pleasing in head properties with a somewhat broader back-skull, steady on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> SAUNDERS, Miss M & NEWTON, Mr Richard Teisgol Calendula

#### **PUPPY DOG** (5 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> MILLETT, Mr R & Mrs L Laveto Remember When, 11 months, well grown, ample bone and substance, pleasing flow of neck and back-line with well set croup and tail placement, strong shapely quarters, impressive on the move with correct use of tail.

2<sup>nd</sup> STILGOE, Mr And Mrs P And D & FOX, Mrs Teisgol Sweet William

3<sup>rd</sup> SAUNDERS, Miss M & NEWTON, Mr Teisgol Calendula

#### **JUNIOR DOG** (3 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> HARRISON, Mrs J Millpoint Watson, 15 months, presents with a stylish overall appearance when stacked, pleases in head properties, clean neck, shapely and well-muscled quarters, ample ribbing, a little untidy and erratic on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> TRUEMAN, Mrs Millpoint Bamburgh Boy, 15 months, pleases for shape and outline, fair head, somewhat lacking in substance and not quite the overall masculinity of the winner.

3<sup>rd</sup> HENSHAW, Miss A & GOODCHILD, Mr J Berseydale Straight Flush with Peteshe (Imp MLT)

#### **YEARLING DOG** (7 Entries, Abs: 1)

1<sup>st</sup> MARSH, Mrs Alozia Zealandia for Ratchda JW, classical type and quality, refined head of correct shape and proportions and with the desired chiselling of the cheek bones, well-shaped and placed ears, gentle expression, shows the desired flow and symmetry of outline that characterises the breed, well set tail of correct shape and length, in hard condition and pleases on the move, just needs time to mature in body and fulfil his potential.

2<sup>nd</sup> ANTHONY, Mrs J Jilony Zeuss, pleases very much in head properties, strong clean neck, good expanse and length of rib, not quite the overall symmetry of the winner and didn't really settle on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> GANNEY, Ms & NORBURY, Mrs Heartbury Matador JW

#### **POST GRADUATE DOG** (7 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> TRUEMAN, Mrs Bradleypoint Floki, BSB, pleases in head properties, typical eye and expression, well muscled clean neck, strong quarters, stands well over his ground, in workmanlike condition, pleasing tail set and carriage, a little high stepping on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> MENNEN, Miss & SWEENEY, Mr Joneva Just Imagine JW, a little more upright in construction than winner and not quite as appealing in expression, clean neck, firm back-line, pleasing tail set and carriage, active mover.

3<sup>rd</sup> MOULE, Mrs & TATE, Mrs Codnorhawk Scott Andrew

**MID LIMIT DOG** (5 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> PHILO, Ms S Sunhouse Black Is Back at Salmonmist JW (ai), pleases for type and style, masculine build and demeanour, well balanced and proportioned head with good eye and expression, well muscled neck, firm top-line, well-muscled and active on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> TRUEMAN, Mrs Bradleypoint Floki

3<sup>rd</sup> WEAVER, Mrs Dappleline Chance for Anniezu

**LIMIT DOG** (6 Entries, Abs: 2)

1<sup>st</sup> HILL, Miss V & HILL, Mrs A & HILL, Miss L Kanix Sourdough with Calaquendi JW Be Jr Ch, up to size, pleasing balance and construction, in firm condition, carries himself well on the move, balanced head of good proportions, would prefer more definition of cheekbones.

2<sup>nd</sup> GUY, Mrs C & TUTHILL, Mr & Mrs Cumbrian Night King at Carofel (Imp USA), very typey exhibit that pleases in many ways, correct head, eye and expression, super coat, well set and carried tail, steady mover.

3<sup>rd</sup> HAWKES, Mr & ROBINSON, Mr & SMITH, Mrs Codnorhawk Brucie Bonus via Tzaziki

**OPEN DOG** (7 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> ODDIE, Miss A Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW, CC, medium size, well put together with a clean and symmetrical outline, impresses on the move with a well balanced, low to ground stride, bone and substance commensurate with his size, used his tail well on the move, head markings detract somewhat from expression and balance of skull but his other qualities gave him the edge in today's entry of males.

2<sup>nd</sup> MARTIN, Mrs & MARTIN, Miss Sunhouse You're Nicked, Res CC, stylish and imposing exhibit, stands well over his ground, fluid and symmetrical outline, pleasing ratio for length of muzzle and back-skull, well finished flews, pleasing eye and expression, in workmanlike condition, well set and carried tail, well muscled quarters, not quite as settled nor as accurate on the mover as winner.

3<sup>rd</sup> OLIVER, Miss & STILGOE, Mr And Mrs P And D Sh Ch Teisgol Love Is In The Air

**VETERAN DOG** (2 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> SMITH, Mrs Sniperay Lord Lambourne via Tzaziki, 7 year old, pleases for type and style, excellent dentition, really nice head with pleasing eye and expression, flowing outline, well-set croup and tail, in hard muscular condition, making the most of himself on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> WELCH, Mrs S & HAZELTINE, Miss Sh Ch Pytchley Chasing The Dream for Hookwood JW, pleases in head, eye and expression, pleasing overall make and shape but not as pleasing in croup as winner and didn't really settle on the move.

**SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG** (3 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> TRUEMAN, Mrs Bradleypoint Floki

2<sup>nd</sup> MOULE, Mrs & TATE, Mrs Codnorhawk Scott Andrew, pleases in in head, eye and expression, clean, well muscled neck, firm top-line, a little light in rear quarters, pleasing profile gait.

3<sup>rd</sup> CLINTON, Mrs L Hawkfield Happy Feet at Oramiss

**MINOR PUPPY BITCH** (2 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> FOX, Mrs L & STILGOE, Mr P & STILGOE, Mrs D Teisgol Rose Champion, 8 months sibling of winner of minor puppy dog class, well-shaped feminine head, pleasing eye and expression, well constructed fore and aft, pleasing flow and symmetry of outline, steady and active on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> PEARSON, Mrs Ladyhawke Winning Colors, 8 months, shows promise but not quite as together as winner and didn't really settle on the move.

**PUPPY BITCH** (5 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> WILKINSON, Mrs Ferndel Sapphire Mist over Stocksfell, BP, 9 months, feminine head showing correct balance and proportions, dark eye with gentle expression, very pleasing flow and symmetry of outline, good length of rib, well coupled and has a most pleasing and typical side gait, clean limbs and well boned, just needs to fill in forechest to complete the picture.

2<sup>nd</sup> ODDIE, Miss A & DYER, Mrs & ERSKINE, Ms T Sharnphilly Elsie Mo to Riowood, 10 months, makes a striking first impression, just slightly broader in skull and shorter in muzzle than winner, pleases for make and shape, stylish on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> GERRARD, Mrs & BELL, Mrs C & GALLOWAY, Mr Riowood C'mon It's Time for Carmandine

**JUNIOR BITCH** (3 Entries, Abs: 1)

1<sup>st</sup> TIMOTHY, Mrs K & O'NEILL, Mrs Tenshilling Sweet Nothins, pleases for shape and balance, typical head, eye and expression, calm and settled on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> ROBSON, Miss Bradgate Dasher, not quite the finish of winner and not quite as pleasing in flow and symmetry of outline.

**YEARLING BITCH** (5 Entries, Abs: 1)

1<sup>st</sup> ADAMS, Mr Joneva Just One Wish, imposing exhibit with an overall pleasing make and shape, good balance of skull to muzzle with a dark eye and gentle expression, shows depth and strength of body, ample bone and substance, moves on a powerful ground covering stride.

2<sup>nd</sup> TIMOTHY, Mrs K & O'NEILL, Mrs Tenshilling Sweet Nothins,

3<sup>rd</sup> COBDEN, Mrs Alozia Zantini

**POST GRADUATE BITCH** (12 Entries, Abs: 2)

1<sup>st</sup> GUY, Mrs C Carofel If I Had Wings JW, stylish and typey exhibit, appeals in head, eye and expression, pleasing size, conformation and proportions, clean limbed and uses herself well on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> LAKE, Miss C Lithespirit Daisy Hamilton, pretty head and appealing eye and expression, stylish on the move, not quite the flow of outline of the winner.

3<sup>rd</sup> MOULE, Mrs Kay & MOULE, Mr Codnorhawk Daisy Dingdong

**MID LIMIT BITCH** (4 Entries, Abs: 1)

1<sup>st</sup> BOULTON, Mrs & BOULTON, Ms Codnorhawk Starlight on Moreoldglen, shapely outline, strong bodied, well-balanced head, clean limbed, pleasing bone and feet, moved out well on strong and purposeful gait.

2<sup>nd</sup> MATTHEWS, Mrs Sonham C'est La Vie, somewhat finer in build than winner, refined head properties, pleasing shape and symmetry of outline, active on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> BROOKSMITH, Miss Nightgold Pipkin

**LIMIT BITCH** (7 Entries, Abs: 1)

1<sup>st</sup> WELCH, Mrs S & DRAKE, Mrs & HAZELTINE, Miss Clamerkin Jubilee Surprise at Hookwood, pleasing to go over with her well made body and pleasing head, well muscled and in hard condition, strong neck, good top-line and strong active gait with correct tail carriage.

2<sup>nd</sup> WILKINSON, Mrs Stocksfell Shockwave, not moving as impressively as winner but nonetheless has a pleasing outline, appeals in head properties with a gentle expression, ample strength and depth of body with pleasing bone and substance.

3<sup>rd</sup> NORBURY, Mrs & NORBURY, Mr & ADAMS Heartbury Northern Lights JW

**OPEN BITCH** (4 Entries, Abs: 2)

1<sup>st</sup> SIDDLE, Mrs & SIDDLE, Miss & MEDEIROS Sh Ch Wilchrimane Frankly Darlin, CC & BOB, could not be denied the top spot in today's entry, ultra feminine yet shows the necessary strength and depth of body, just a shade broad and full in back-skull, dark and expressive eye, clean neck, excellent ribbing, clean limbed with correct feet, super coat, correctly carried and used bee-sting tail, well muscled quarters, has a tendency to appear over-angulated in the rear when stacked but she nonetheless moves on an impressive, well balanced, free and easy, ground covering stride with absolutely no signs of over-reaching or side-winding.

2<sup>nd</sup> GERRARD, BELL, & GALLOWAY, Sh Ch Chesterhope C'mon Over to Carmandine (Imp NZL), Res CC, impresses very much for her breed type and quality, has the cleanest of heads and her outline is both symmetrical and flowing give a lissom appearance, she is well-ribbed with a strong loin and pleasing couplings with well muscled quarters and a pleasing tail set and carriage, just not quite as clean in front assembly as the winner.

**VETERAN BITCH** (4 Entries, Abs: 0)

1<sup>st</sup> MATTHEWS, Mrs Medogold Tartini with Sonham JW ShCM ShCEx OSW, BV, impressive 8 year old in excellent condition, typical heads and expression, pleases in construction, ample depth and strength of body and impresses on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> LAKE, Miss C Wild Thyme, another impressive 8 year old, typical make and shape, sweet head with gentle expression, clean neck, firm top-line, not quite as strong in rear action as winner.

3<sup>rd</sup> HARRISON, Mrs J Sh Ch Millpoint Simply Scrumptus JW

**SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH** (6 Entries, Abs: 3)

1<sup>st</sup> MOULE, Mrs & MOULE, Mr Codnorhawk Daisy Dingdong, well grown with pleasing flow and symmetry of outline, typical head properties, well ribbed back, steady mover.

2<sup>nd</sup> KLAIBER, Mrs Sharnphilly Gingerbread Sgwc, pretty head, good eye and expression, stacks up well but a little upright in forearm and has a tendency to fly her tail on the move.

3<sup>rd</sup> ROBSON, Miss Codnorhawk Dinky Stta at Bradgate.
