1st Bowen-Brooks, Tenshilling Blowin Smoke: An 8-year old male, well balanced all through, masculine head with good depth of stop. Very clean all through with slightly arched neck into well placed shoulder assembly. Correct, clean and complete dentition, chest of very good depth and width with elbows on brisket. Very good length of ribcage with good spring of rib. Strong, muscular hindquarters and hocks well let down. Moved smoothly and soundly with good tail action.

2nd Philo, Fydal Caprio at Salmonmist JW ShCM OSW VW: Another Veteran male of 8 years of age. Well muscled throughout, skull of medium length, dentition correct, clean and complete, strong neck and forequarters, well sprung ribs, short coupled, strong hindquarters, moved well covering plenty of ground on the best of feet with short nails.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1st Osman, Fleurfield Benjamin Button with Marissolo: Very good overall balance and type. His head has a pronounced stop, which in turn gives the correct appearance. Correct, clean and complete dentition. Clean neck of super length into well placed shoulder and return of upper arm. Deep chest, well ribbed back, moderate and muscular hindquarters – moved soundly once settled.

PUPPY DOG (4)

1st Smith, Smith & Welch, Quinnery Middle Wallop by Lypal: Well balanced all through, presented and shwn very well. Good head with correct, clean and complete dentition, clean neck into very good shoulder assembly, very good depth and width of brisket, muscular loin, moderate and muscular hindquarters. Moved very well with drive and soundly. BPIB

1st Smith & Smith & Welch, Quinnery Middle Wallop by Lypal

2nd Smith & Smith & Welch, Quinnery Swinderby by Lypal: Pleasing male overall with good head. Correct, clean and complete dentition. Very good shoulder assembly, chest of good depth, well ribbed back into loin of good proportions, moderate hindquarters with hocks well let down. Moved soundly.

YEARLING DOG (3)

1st Wilcox, Harvestslade Fire And Ice through Merynjen JW; I really liked this young male for his overall balance, size and outline. Very good head and skull. Dentition correct, clean and complete, muscular and slightly arched neck. Well placed shoulders and corresponding return of upper arm, chest deep, brisket to level with elbows. Short coupled, muscular hindquarters, well turned stifles and hocks well let down, coat short and hard. Super smooth movement covering plenty of ground with driving hind action.

2nd Clinton, Sonham Just Over The Moon at Oramiss (AI): Well balanced all through with very good head and dentition that was both correct, clean and complete. Well laid shoulder and return of upper arm. Ribcage of good length and well sprung. Moderate and muscular hindquarters. Moved soundly.

2nd Booth & Oddie, Lundgarth Fly The Flag: Of good proportions, balanced, good bone and correct feet, good head with correct and complete dentition leading to muscular and slightly arched neck, very good forehand assembly, excellent depth of chest, good body, muscular hindquarters, very good feet, moved well.

3rd Brough, Haramander Ace Of Hearts

1st Bailey & Bailey, Wilchrimane Silent Bounty: A very pleasing male all through – presented and shown very well. Very good head. Dentition correct, clean and complete, muscular and slightly arched neck. Well placed shoulder assembly, chest deep, brisket to level with elbows. Muscular hindquarters, well turned stifles and hocks well let down. Excellent and correct movement in all planes.

2nd Cooper, & Pearson, Keepersfield Hope And Glory: Presented an excellent outline of balance and breed type. Balanced and symmetrical male, well muscled throughout, skull of medium length, correct mouth, strong neck and well made forequarters, well sprung ribs, short coupled, strong and muscled hindquarters, moved soundly covering plenty of ground.

3rd Brough, Haramander Ace Of Hearts

POST GRADUATE DOG (3)

1st Welch, Hookwood Starman JW: Super quality male. Very well balanced all through. Very good head that is correctly proportioned with deep stop, correct, clean and complete dentition. Excellent lay of shoulder with corresponding return of upper arm. Level topline. Chest of good depth and with elbows on level with brisket. Well ribbed back. Very strong and muscular hindquarters. Excellent bone all through. Strong driving movement with good tail action. Reserve Dog Challenge Certificate.

2nd Isherwood, Wilchrimane Let's Be Frank: I preferred the overall outline and balance of my first placed exhibit. This male is however a very nice example of the breed. Very good head with deep stop and clean cheeks. Dentition correct, clean and complete. Neck clean and of good length. Very good forehand assembly, deep chest with ribs well spung, Mderate and muscled hindquarters, moved soundly. 3rd Webster, Joneva Just Goes To Show at Errytar

LIMIT DOG (9)

1st Philo, Sunhouse Black is Back at Salmonmist: A very striking male of just over 2½ years of age who I considered for higher honours. Very well made all through with excellent bone and feet. Typical head with good stop and dentition that was correct, clean and complete. Clean slightly arched neck into very good forehand assembly, deep chest, well ribbed back and moderate hindquarters that are muscular. Moved sodly with correct action and good use of tail.

2nd Webb, Tenshilling Jimmy Mack JW: Another very pleasing male of 3½ years of age. Presented and shown well. Well balanced with good outline. I preferred the overall outline and head of my first placed exhibit. Dentition correct clean and complete. Very good reach of neck into a well placed shoulder assembly, deep chest, moderate hindquarters that can appear over angulated depending on how he is presented. Moved soundly.

1st Hill, Hill & Hill, Kanix Sourdough with Calaquendi JW Be Jr Ch: A very striking and masculine male of almost 3 years of age. I wouldn't want him any bigger, but he is not coarse in any way and completely balanced all through. Very good head and super clean outline both when standing and moving. Dentition correct, clean and complete. Very good shoulder placement and return of upper arm, deep chest of very good width, ribs well sprung, muscular hindquarters, very good bone and feet – move correctly and soundly in all planes. My absolute pleasure to award him the Dog Challenge Certificate his 3RD I understand – congratulations.

2nd Oddie, Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW: Well balanced through, presenting correct and pleasing outline. For me, he needs to show more work in his head, dentition correct, clean and complete. Clean neck into good forehand assembly. Very good depth and width of brisket. Muscular hindquarters. Moved soundly.

3rd Adams, Sh Ch Carofel Wings Of Hope JW Ww23 Swiss Jr Ch

1st Clinton, Sonham Just Over The Moon at Oramiss (AI): A male of 14 months of age. I really liked him for his overall type and stature. Correct and typical breed head. Dentition correct, clean and complete, Eyes correctly placed. Very good clean neck. Well balanced throughout and without exaggeration. Excellent forehand assembly, deep chest, short-coupled. On the move he demonstrated sound, breed correct movement

2nd Green & Green, Hookwood Hawker: A male of 18 months of age. Well presented and shown. Balanced all through. Pleasing head and expression, dentition correct, clean and complete. Very good clean neck. Well balanced throughout and without exaggeration. Deep chest, short-coupled. Moved Soundly. 3rd Kuzbari, Kananaskis Galliago

VETERAN BITCH (3)

1st Welch, Maber & Hazeltine, Sharnphilly Toggi with Hookwood JW: A bitch of 7½ years of age. Well presented and shown. Good overall balance and type. Pleasing head of correct proportions with well defined stop. Dentition correct, clean and complete. Very good clean neck of good reach into good forehand assembly. Excellent depth of chest, loin of optimum length for me. Moderate and muscular hindquarters. Moved soundly.

2nd Preece & Gilding, Harvestslade Lesedi La Rona: A bitch of 8 years of age, of good size and proportions and balanced. Good head, long muscular neck into well, placed shoulders, good depth of chest, muscular hindquarters, and Oval tight feet. Moved well.

3rd Isherwood, Symitry Iced Ginger

1st Parkin & Parkin, Fleurfield Henrrietta Hayes at Ellapoint: A very nice and well presented and shown puppy of almost 8 months of age. Very well balanced. Excellent outline and overall profile. Super head with well pronounced stop. Dentition correct, clean and complete. Very good and clean neck leading seamlessly into very good forehand assembly. Deep in brisket with good width of chest. Very good hindquarters with good turn of stifle. Correct topline, bone and feet. Moved out well and soundly.

2nd Upton-Lovett & Upton, Heartbury Endless Love with Roydeck: Slightly larger all through than my winner. Good head with pronounced stop, dentition correct, clean and complete. Clean neck leading into well laid shoulder, chest deep with elbows placed close to brisket. Well sprung ribcage. Moderate turn of stifle, Moved well.

Head of correct proportions with ears set correctly Dentition correct, clean and complete. Clean and slightly arched neck, very good forehand construction. Chest of good depth. Well sprung ribcage of good length. Level topline. Well made hindquarters with correct bend of stifle. Moved very well.

2nd Barham, Droveborough Witchy Woman: Slightly larger than my first placed bitch. Well balanced. Very good head and skull. Dentition correct, clean and complete, muscular and slightly arched neck. Well placed shoulders and corresponding return of upper arm. Short coupled, muscular hindquarters, well turned stifles and hocks well let down, coat short and hard. Smooth movement covering plenty of ground with driving hind action. Extremely well handled.

1st Stilgoe & Stilgoe, Teisgol Rose Campion JW: A very pleasing bitch. Extremely well balanced with very good bone and substance. Very good head and skull. Correct, clean and complete dentition. Muscular and slightly arched neck. Correct layback of shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm, chest deep, brisket to level with elbows. Well muscled hindquarters, coat short. Moved extremely well,

2nd Matthews, Sonham Just Good Friends (AI): Presented a very pleasing overall outline. Good proportions, balanced, good bone and correct feet, good head with correct and complete dentition leading to muscular and slightly arched neck, very good forehand assembly, excellent depth of chest, good body, muscular hindquarters, very good feet, moved well.

1st Barham, Droveborough Witchy Woman.

2nd Maude, Hawkfield Devil Wears Prada: Well balanced and pleasing to the eye. Typical head with good stop. Marginally steep in upper arm. Dentition correct, clean and complete. Deep chest, muscled hindquarters, moved soundly.

3rd Carver & Carver, Oldbashurst Country Life

GRADUATE BITCH (7)

1st Barham, Alozia Zephryne: A bitch that I liked very much for her clean lines and overall balance. In the final line up she was immature, which stopped me awarding her higher honours. Very good head and skull and pronounced stop. Correct, clean and complete dentition. Muscular and slightly arched neck. Correct layback of shoulder and corresponding return of upper arm, chest deep, brisket to level with elbows. Well muscled hindquarters. Moved extremely well,

2nd Cobden, Alozia Zantini: Litter sister to my first placed bitch – my defining decision was made due to a marginally higher foot fall than the first placed bitch. Super clean in outline and balance. Excellent breed type. Very good head and expression with pronounced stop. Dentition correct, clean and complete. Excels in forehand construction. Good spring of rib. Moderate and muscled hindquarters. Moved well.

1st Parkin, Keepersfield Simone: A mixed class where I could not really find the absolute type that I was seeking. Bitch of good proportions, and of pleasing overall type and balance, good and correct head, correct, clean and complete dentition, clean neck good shoulder, deep chest moderate hindquarters angulation. Moved well and soundly.

2nd Wynne-Evans, Droveborough Frost Queen: A bitch of pleasing proportions but not the typical outline that I was looking for. Pleasing head and expression and pronounced stop. Lean neck into good forehand assembly. Dentition Correct, clean and complete. Well sprung ribs, strong loin. Moderate turn of stifle. Moved soundly.

3rd Barham, Droveborough Mocha Mayhem

LIMIT BITCH (6)

1st Welch, Drake & Hazeltine, Clamarkin Jubilee Surprise at Hookwood: An outstanding bitch in every respect – she just lacks maturity, which would have seen her be awarded the Bitch Challenge Certificate. Beautifully balanced all through. Feminine. Excellent head proportions with well defined stop. Excels in forehand assembly. Excellent depth and width of brisket. Muscular hindquarters with moderate turn of stifle and well let down hocks. Very good bone and feet. She excels on the move with her accurate movement and super forward reach. RCC

2nd Cooper & Pearson, Keepersfield Giselle: Good overall balance. Her head has a pronounced stop giving dished like appearance. Correct clean and complete dentition. Clean neck leading to good lay of shoulder and return of upper arm. Deep chest. Well ribbed back. Correctly set tail. Well made hindquarters with good width of second thigh. On the move she demonstrated an excellent side profile.

3rd Stilgoe & Fox, Teisgol Snow Queen

OPEN BITCH (9, 2abs)

1st Siddle, Siddle & Medeiros, Sh Ch Wilchrimane Frankly Darlin: Excellent in overall balance, type and construction. True head with well defined stop, dentition correct, clean and complete. Clean slightly arched neck into excellent shoulder placement and return of upper arm. Well ribbed back and ribs well sprung. Muscular hindquarters. Excels in movement in all planes. My only observation would be that when stacked she can 'appear' slightly over-angulated on the hindquarters. CC & BOB

2nd Martin & Martin, Sunhouse Partners In Crime: I loved the type and balance of this bitch, pleasing head, correct, clean and complete dentition, strong neck into well placed shoulders. Good depth and spring of ribcage. Strong topline with correct tailset. Well made hindquarters with moderate turn of stifle. On the move she was accurate and sound.

3rd Webb, Sh Ch Tenshilling The Wanderer.
