1<sup>st</sup> O'Neill's Tenshilling Shboom JW. 22 mths with lovely balanced head of good shape, has strength in neck, good front assembly, lovely ribbing, strong over loin and rear, moved out positively.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wilcox's Harvestslade Fire And Ice through Merynjen JW. Head of good shape with balance, strength in the right places, stood true, well ribbed but just carrying a little too much on his shoulders today, moved out with purpose.

Now 7 years and still shows the youngsters how to move, he is all male, lovely well balanced head of correct shape, strong neck, well laid shoulders, true front, lovely depth and ribbing, strong in loin and rear, on the move he shows power and keeps a good topline covering the ring with purpose and at one with handler, he demanded the CC.
