#### **PUPPY DOG** (Entries 3, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Wilchrimane Florin to Olivesong (Oliver). Mature 10 month old with a pleasing overall outline and good bone and substance. Masculine head, well ribbed body with good rear angulation, presenting a balanced outline. Shown in lovely condition and moving with a sound ground covering stride.

2<sup>nd</sup> Heartbury Caraxes (Norbury). Very raw 7 months but with a good well constructed frame to develop into. Pleasing head with good proportions. Good neck and shoulders, balanced body with plenty of rear angulation. Lovely outline standing just needs to develop with maturity. Moved as expected of a young puppy enjoying his day.

3<sup>rd</sup> Riowood Cherry Bomb (Senior).

#### **JUNIOR DOG** (Entries 1, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Chesterhope Agent Orange at Carmandine (Imp NZL) (Gerrard & Bell & Galloway). Smart young dog just out of puppy, full of quality and type, a series of graceful curves. Lovely head with plenty of work in it, and a kind eye and expression, well constructed front in a deep well ribbed body with good bone. He scored in quarters, they are well developed and produce excellent rear positive driving movement. Standing he presented a picture of balance. Close up in the challenge for the Res CC, just needs to mature a little more and steady in front movement.

#### **POST GRADUATE DOG** (Entries 5, Absentees 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Sharnphilly Black Abbott JW (Swannell). Pleasing in overall type and balance, with a masculine refined head with plenty of work in it, deep well ribbed body, lovely bone and substance, strong muscular hind quarters, good tail. Moved soundly covering the ground with good reach and drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> Laveto Remember When (Millett). Very similar in construction and type to 1. I see they have the same sire and possess the same qualities. Balanced with good bone, pleasing in size and outline. Moved with drive just preferred front on winner.

3<sup>rd</sup> Raigmore Defender Of Faith (Black).

#### **LIMIT DOG** (Entries 6, Absentees 3)

1<sup>st</sup> Riowood Orange Twist (Millett). Pleasing in overall type and well constructed throughout from a pleasing head, through a well made body with good front and rear angulation. I would just prefer a little more masculine in head and bone. Sound mover just gets a little proud of his tail at times.

2<sup>nd</sup> Tenshilling Jimmy Mack JW (Webb). Another pleasing overall for type and construction just preferred the head on 1. Balanced outline with plenty bone and substance, moved with a good side gait.

3<sup>rd</sup> Droveborough's Follow Me at Frenetbull (Fraser).

**OPEN DOG** (Entries 7, Absentees 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Berseydale Poker Face (Feichtinger). A quality male who I found moderate and extremely well balanced throughout everything, flowing from head to tail. His head isn't classical, however has good proportions with a pleasing eye and expression, fine ears which he used well. He presented a balanced body with good rib, well constructed front and rear angulation, strong topline and lovely short tail carried well. When asked to move he did it positively with an effortless ground covering stride. A pleasure to award him the CC (his 3<sup>rd</sup>) and BOB and see him take G4.

2<sup>nd</sup> Davigdor Flanders Field (Gordon). Another quality male who I found un-exaggerated throughout, balanced with plenty of bone and substance, lovely head and eye, deep well made body with good angulation front and rear. He presented a picture of a flowing outline masculine with nothing overdone. His movement was positive and outgoing, at times a little erratic in front, I feel due to the change in handlers, but did enough to achieve his place and the Res CC.

3<sup>rd</sup> Sh Ch/bel Ch Kanix Sourdough with Calaquendi JW Bel Jch (Hill).

**VETERAN DOG** (Entries 1, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Sh Ch Kanix Peri Peri with Glenfinnan (Jamieson, Macara & Blackburn-Bennett). Pleasing in overall balance, masculine head with good eye, deep well made body with well angulated and muscled rear. Presenting a good outline standing and on the move. Shown in lovely coat and condition. Moved with a positive stride covering the ground well.

**SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG** (Entries 1, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Droveborough's Follow Me at Frenetbull (Fraser). Masculine headed male, deep well ribbed body could have better shoulder angulation and would like more strength in rear movement, has good side gait and is a happy outgoing temperament. Shown in excellent coat & condition. BSB

**GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME DOG** (Entries 2, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Sunhouse Black Is Back at Salmonmist JW ShCEX OSW (ai) (Philo). All male who presents a flowing outline. Masculine head and dark eye, deep well ribbed body with strong topline, good bone and substance and pleasing overall in balance. When asked to move he covers the ground with a good side gait, would just prefer more strength in rear.

2<sup>nd</sup> Freebreeze On Location at Brackenstyle (Heaton). Pleasing headed male with good eye and expression, balanced moderate outline just lacking a little in depth of chest Preferred the movement on winner.

**PUPPY BITCH** (Entries 5, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Riowood Cherry Jubilee at Sharnphilly (Oddie). Loved the overall balance and construction on this quality puppy, from her pretty head she flowed through well constructed front a deep balanced body with a moderately angled strong rear. She presented a picture of balance and quality with a lovely short tail and strong topline. When asked to move for 6 months she did so extremely well covering the ground positively with enthusiasm and style. A very promising puppy BPIB.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wilchrimane Flomotion for Sandbears NAF (Blake). Another nicely made bitch who presented a picture standing of balance and flowing lines, Pleasing overall for bone substance and construction. Moved soundly.

3<sup>rd</sup> Freebreeze Gertrude Stein at Luneville (Macmanus).

**JUNIOR BITCH** (Entries 3, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Daledancer Frances Mullen (Anderson-Rowell). Feminine headed bitch of good size, bone and substance. Balanced body with plenty of rear angulation. Presented a good outline and moved soundly, would just like more extension in front.

2<sup>nd</sup> Hawkfield Bewitched (Gordon). 12 months and very immature and lacking in body however, is well constructed front and rear and has a pleasing feminine head. She presented a balanced outline and moved with a good side gait. Just needs time to mature.

3<sup>rd</sup> Millpoint Spread Your Wings over Vabisbrae (Collins).

**POST GRADUATE BITCH** (Entries 6, Absentees 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Sonham Just Good Friends (ai) JW (Matthews). Balanced bitch of good size, and substance, feminine head of good proportions would just like a little more work between the eyes. Good front assembly in a deep balanced body with a strong well angulated rear. Presented a flowing outline standing and, on the move, which she did soundly with drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> Lundgarth Ticket To Fly JW (Booth). Feminine head with good eye, deep well ribbed body with strong muscular rear, presenting a good balanced outline. Moved soundly just preferred shoulder on winner.

3<sup>rd</sup> Riowood Blackberry at Fallowfield (Lewis).

**LIMIT BITCH** (Entries 8, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Sharnphilly Dizzy Blonde at Linosa (Gates). Quality bitch of lovely type, bone and substance. Feminine head with good eye and ear, deep well ribbed body with lovely legs and feet. Strong muscular well angled hindquarters, she presented a balanced flowing outline. Shown in excellent coat and condition. She moved soundly with a good stride to win the class and pushed hard for the CC just lacked a little animation in the challenge. Res CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Joneva Just One Wish JW (Adams). Another top quality bitch, with feminine head, clean flowing shoulder into deep well ribbed body and well developed rear. She presents a lovely balanced outline and is shown in good coat. She moved with a good side gait and topline, just a little erratic at times.

3<sup>rd</sup> Kanix Smoochie at Stargang (Blackburn-Bennett).

**OPEN BITCH** (Entries 7, Absentees 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Sh Ch Tenshilling The Wanderer (Webb). Here I found another quality bitch moderate and unexaggerated throughout, feminine head of good proportions, well constructed front, a deep well ribbed body and strong muscular hindquarters, all go to give her a picture of a balanced flowing outing. Add to this her sound positive enthusiastic movement covering the ground effortlessly. Pleased to award her the CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Kanix Skyfall (Blackburn-Bennett). Another nicely made bitch throughout, mature in body with pleasing head, good bone and substance, presented a flowing outline of balance and type. Moved with a good side gait covering the ground well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Joneva Just A Kiss JW ShCEx OSW Cw25/26 (Fewster).

**SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH** (Entries 2, Absentees 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Millpoint Spread Your Wings over Vabisbrae (Collins). Pleasing in outline and body condition with good bone, feminine head just needs more work between the eye. Won the class on overall balance and substance. Moved ok.

2<sup>nd</sup> Raigmore Hermia of Vabisbrae (Collins). Pleasing in overall outline just lacked some bone and substance. Moved ok with a happy outgoing stride.
