I thoroughly enjoyed judging this lovely breed. The weather was very challenging with high winds making the marquee rattle. It upset many dogs so one had to be forgiving. That having been said there were very few dogs that moved with the true daisy cutting action.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (7,2)

1st Teisgol Snow Prince Charmin (Saunders & Newton). Nicely made with good overall balance. Head will shape giving dish faced appearance with ears set high. Long neck leading to well laid shoulder. Good depth of chest for age. Well ribbed back. Well turned stifles. Good bone and feet. Moved steadily.
2nd Pharies Drake (Bond). Well balanced all through. Correct head shape with well defined stop and high set ears. Long neck leading to good layback of shoulder. Long depth of chest for his age and well ribbed back. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles and good movement with light gait action. BPD and BP.
3rd Droveborough Super Trooper (Irshad)

PUPPY DOG (4)

1st Wilchrimane Florin to Olivesong (Oliver). Super smart puppy. Well balanced and when stacked presents a symmetrical outline. Lovey head with good stop and pronounced occiput. Long neck leading to good layback of shoulder. Good depth of chest for his age and well ribbed back. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles. Moved out well with good tail action. RPD and RP.
2nd Teisgol Snow Prince Charmin. (Saunders & Newton) 1st MPD.
3rd Wilchrimane Tunaverse (Siddle, Siddle & Bailey & Bailey).

JUNIOR DOG (4)

1st Millpoint Mr Loverman (Harrison). Good overall balance. Head well shaped with deep stop and slight depression beneath the eyes. Long neck leading to very good lay of shoulder. His chest is of good depth and ribs are carried well back. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles. Good bone. Moved out on a good stride.
2nd Sunhouse Quintessential (Martin). Well balanced all through. Good head with deep stop and prominent occiput bone. High set ears. Good length of neck. I just preferred the layback of shoulder on the winner. Deep chest and good length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters with nicely turned stifles. Moved out well.
3rd Corotine Velvet Tuxedo (Saunders & Newton).

YEARLING DOG (4)

1st Lundgarth Fly The Flag JW (Booth & Oddie). Well balanced all through. Head is nicely shaped with slightly concave muzzle with ears set high. Good length of neck into well laid shoulder. Enough depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters with good turn of stifle. Moved on a good stride.
2nd Quinners Swinderby by Lypal (Smith, Smith & Welch). Good overall balance. Head is well shaped with pronounced stop and slight depression beneath the eyes. Long neck leading to well laid shoulders. Deep chest and good length of ribcage. Strong hindquarters. Preferred movement of winner.
3rd Tenshilling Catch The Wind (Angus & O'Neill).

1st Wilchrimane Florin to Olivesong (Oliver). 1st PD.
2nd Millpoint Mr Loverman (Harrison). 1st JD.
3rd Corotine Velvet Tuxedo (Saunders & Newton).

GRADUATE DOG (8,1)

1st Alcazar Excalibur (Dunnett). This dog is very well balanced and presents a lovely outline when stacked. Head is nicely proportioned with medium breadth of skull, well defined stop and high set ears. Long, slightly arched neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Brisket reaches to the elbows and good length of ribcage. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles. Moved well with good tail action. Could just carry a fraction less weight, but otherwise a very nice dog.

2nd Quinnersy Svinderby by Lypal (Smith, Smith & Welch). 2nd YD.

3rd Teisgol Calendula JW (Saunders & Newton).

POST GRADUATE DOG (7)

1st Tenshilling Shboom JW (O'Neill). Well balanced all through presenting typical breed outline of symmetrical curves. Good head with appearance of a dish face, well defined stop and high set ears. Long neck leading to excellent lay of shoulder. Good depth of chest and ribs carried well back. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles. Good bone and feet. Moved out well with a good tail action.

2nd Alcazar Excalibur (Dunnett) 1st GD.

3rd Sharnphilly Black Abbott JW (Swannell).

LIMIT DOG (7)

1st Teisgol Sweet William JW (Stigoe & Fox). Good overall balance presenting a good outline. Head is well shaped with defined stop and pronounced occiput bone. Long slightly arched neck leading to well laid shoulder. Good depth of chest with brisket reaching to the elbows. Well ribbed back. Scores in hindquarters with a very well muscled and powerful. Moved on a very good stride with a good tail action. Not far off in the final reckoning.

2nd Ladyhawke Desert Orchid (Pearson). Another quality dog who is well balanced all through. Particularly liked his head with gives the appearance of being dish faced, well defined stop and slight depression beneath the eyes. Good length of neck leading to well laid shoulder. Correct depth of chest and ribs go well back. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles. Moved well, not quite the drive of the winner.

3rd Joneva Just Goes To Show at Errytar (Webster).

OPEN DOG (7,2)

1st Sh Ch Teisgol Love Is In The Air ShCEx Oliver & Stilgoe). Quality dog who is well balanced and presents a typical breed outline when stacked. Head is well shaped with slightly concave muzzle. Slight depression beneath the eyes and well defined stop. Strong slightly arched neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Scores in his hindquarters which are powerful with well turned stifles. Excellent bone and feet. Free movement showing good length of stride and good tail action. CC.

2nd Sh Ch Carofel Wings Of Hope JW VW23 Swiss Ch (Adams). Another quality dog and worthy titleholder. Good overall balance. Super head with well defined stop and prominent occiput bone. Long neck leading to excellent lay of shoulder. Deep chest with good length of ribcage. Powerful hindquarters. Good bone and feet. Moved well but only for rear drive. RCC.

3rd Millpoint Webley (re-Imp) (Harrison).

SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (3)

1st Keepersfield Hope And Glory (Cooper & Pearson). Well balanced all through with good outline. Head nicely shaped with slightly dish faced appearance. High set ears. Long neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Well ribbed back. Nicely made hindquarters with well turned stifles. Moved soundly.

2nd Hawfield King's Ransom (Allen & Betts). Well balanced all through. Not quite the curvy outline of the winner. Good head shape with well defined stop and high set ears. Good length of neck leading to well laid shoulder. I would like a little more depth of chest but he is well ribbed back. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles. Moved on a good stride.

3rd Millpoint Bamburgh Boy (Trueman).

GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME DOG (4,1)

1 Alcazar Excalibur (Dunnett) 1st GD.

2nd Teisgol Calendula JW (Saunders & Newton). 3rd in good Post Graduate class. Presents typical outline when stacked. Well shaped head with correctly defined stop and slight depression beneath the eyes. Long, slightly arched neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Chest of good depth. Well ribbed back. Scores in hindquarters with nicely turned stifles. Good bone and feet. Moved on a good stride.

3rd Meadowpoint Jack O'Lantern at Pointmoor (Walton)

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (5, 1)

1st Riowood Cherry Jubilee at Sharnphilly (Oddie). Just over 6 months old she is well balanced and presents a very good outline. Head is well shaped with well defined stop and pronounced occiput bone. Long neck leading to well laid shoulder. Good depth of chest for her age and well ribbed back. Well made hindquarters with good bend of stifle. Excellent bone and feet. Moved with great confidence for one so young. BPB.

2nd Pharises Doja Cat (Bond & Rawlinson). Well balanced all through. Excellent head with slightly concave muzzle. Well defined stop and high set ears. Good length of neck leading to well laid shoulders. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters. Good bone and feet. Moved on a good stride.

3rd Teisgol Snow Princess (Stilgoe & Fox).

PUPPY BITCH (3)

1st Wilchrimane Flomotion for Sandbears (Blake). Very well made puppy who has a balanced outline. Her head has a well defined stop and pronounced occiput bone. Long neck. To be picky I would like a fraction more layback in shoulder. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters with good bone and feet. Moved out well on a good stride.

2nd Sharnphilly Lyrical (Brooksmith). Good overall balance. Not quite the curved outline of the winner. Good head with slightly concave muzzle and high set ears. Long, slightly arched neck. Good depth of chest and ribs carried well back. Strong hindquarters with well turned stifles. Moved soundly.

3rd Caithpoint Keep The Heid with Monefair (Tregaskis).

JUNIOR BITCH (6)

1st Millpoint Endless Love (Harrison). Aptly named! I loved her! Well balanced all through presenting a typical outline. Her head is correctly shaped with slightly concave muzzle and well defined stop. Long neck leading to excellent lay of shoulder. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Well made hindquarters with nicely turned stifles. Excellent bone and feet. On the move she was a joy to watch, using her tail well. A truly quality bitch who I think will gain her title with ease. RCC.

2nd Teisgol Aurora Borealis at Abbothagg (Wright, Stigoe & Stilgoe & Fox). Good overall balance. Head is well shaped with defined stop and high set ears. Long neck leading to well laid shoulder. Good depth of chest. Well made hindquarters. Moved on a good stride.

3rd Sharphilly Lyrical (Brooksmith).

YEARLING BITCH (6)

1st Sonham Just Good Friends (ai) JW (Matthews). Well balanced all through. Pleasing head with well defined stop and high set ears. Good length of neck and depth of chest. Well ribbed back. Scores in hindquarters with nicely bent stifles and correct hock placement. Moved out well on a good stride.

2nd Droveborough Witchy Woman JW (Barham). Good overall balance. Lovely head with slightly concave muzzle and well defined stop. Long neck. I would prefer more layback of shoulder. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Excellent hindquarters with well bent stifles. Moved soundly.

3rd Teisgol Aurora Borealis at Abbothagg (Wright, Stigoe & Stilgoe & Fox).

NOVICE BITCH (6,1)

1st Millpoint Wings Of Fire (Harrison). Well balanced presenting good outline. Well shaped head with defined stop and high set ears. Long neck leading to well laid shoulder. Good depth of chest. Well ribbed back. Well made hindquarters with nicely bent stifles. Good on a good stride.

2nd Teisgol Snow Princess (Stilgoe & Fox). 3rd in MPB. Well balanced with good outline. Lovely head with slightly concave muzzle and high set ears. Good length of neck leading to well laid shoulder. Depth of chest correct for her age. Good length of ribcage. Super hindquarters with nicely turned stifles and good hock placement. Moved soundly.

3rd Caithpoint Keep The Heid with Monefair (Tregaskis).

GRADUATE BITCH (3)

1st Alozia Zantini (Cobden). This bitch presents a typical outline and is very well balanced. Lovely head shape with slightly concave muzzle, well defined stop and high set ears. Long neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Chest of good depth and ribcage of good length. Well made hindquarters with nicely bent stifles. Excellent bone and feet. Moved out well on a good stride.

2nd Droveborough's Hells Bells JW (Kennedy). Good overall balance. Head is nicely proportioned with well defined stop and pronounced occiput bone. Good length of neck. I would prefer more layback of shoulder. Chest of good depth. Well made hindquarters with nicely turned stifles. Moved soundly.

3rd Lundgarth Jubilee JW (Booth).

POST GRADUATE BITCH (1)

1st Sonham Just A Pretty Belle (ai) JW (Matthews). Well balanced presenting good outline. Head of a good shape with slightly concave muzzle and well defined stop. Long neck leading to well laid shoulder. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Scores in hindquarters with nicely turned stifles and correct hock placement. On the move she was extremely erratic no doubt excited by the high winds which was a shame because I couldn't do any more for her but I did like her.

LIMIT BITCH (7,2)

1st Teisgol Alohomora (Stilgoe & Fox). Another bitch I loved very much who pushed hard for higher honours. Well balanced presenting a typical outline. Good head with well defined stop, pronounced occiput bone and high set ears. Long neck leading to well laid shoulder. Good depth of chest. Well ribbed back. Well made hindquarters with good hock placement. Excellent bone and feet. Moved out well on a good stride.

2nd Keepersfield Giselle (Cooper & Pearson). Well balanced all through. Pleasing head with well defined stop and high set ears. Long neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Good depth of chest and hindquarters carried well back. Preferred the hindquarters of the winner. Moved soundly.

3rd Mattiboo White Queen (Pressley, Large & Large).

OPEN BITCH (4,1)

1st Sh Ch Wilchrimane Frankly Darlin (Siddle, Siddle, Medeiros & Courtelis). This kennel consistently produces excellent stock and this bitch is no exception. May years ago I gave her grandmother, the great Ice Maiden, a CC and BOB and this bitch is so very like her. In a quality entry she stood alone. Beautifully balanced displaying a lovely outline. Her head is correctly proportioned with a slightly concave muzzle and slightly pronounced beneath the eyes. She has a well defined stop highly set ears. Her neck is long and slightly arched leading to excellent lay back of shoulder. Her chest is deep with the brisket reaching the elbows. Ribs carried well back. Hindquarters well muscled with nicely bent stifles. Excellent bone and feet. And then she moved. I could watch her all day, it is so smooth and ground covering with a true daisy cutting action using her tail well. Her handler gets the very best out of her, she just flowed round the ring on a loose lead, it was truly poetry in motion. Delighted to award her the CC and BOB. A truly lovely bitch whom it was an honour to judge.

2nd Sunhouse Partners In Crime (Martin). Well balanced all through. Head is well shaped with slightly concave muzzle and high set ears. Long, slightly arched neck leading to good lay of shoulder. Deep chest and well ribbed back. Scores in hindquarters with nicely bent stifles and well placed hocks. Moved out on a good stride.

3rd Lundgarth Everest JW (Booth).

VETERAN BITCH (2)

1st Nightgold Pipkin (Brooksmith). Good overall balance. Head is nicely proportioned with well defined stop and high set ears. Good length of neck leading to well laid back shoulder. Chest of good depth and ribcage carried well back. Well made hindquarters with nicely bent stifles. Good bone and feet. Moved out well. VB.

2nd Sh Ch Millpoint Simply Scrumptus JW (Harrison). Well balanced all through. Good head shape with slightly concave muzzle and well defined stop. Long neck leading to well laid shoulder. Good depth of chest and length of ribcage. Her hindquarters are fractionally over angulated for my preference. Good bone and feet. Moved soundly.
